In accordance with the requirements of Section 163.3191(1)-(5), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and the Evaluation and Appraisal Notification Schedule 2012-2018 posted on the Department of Economic Opportunity website, the Town of Jupiter must determine if amendments to its Comprehensive Plan are necessary to reflect changes in state requirements and notify the state planning agency of its determination by June 1, 2015.

The Town has evaluated its Comprehensive Plan and determined that amendments are necessary to reflect changes in state requirements. As required by Section 163.3191(2), F.S., the Town understands that the necessary amendments to the Comprehensive Plan must be prepared and transmitted to the state land planning agency within one year, which is by June 1, 2016.


The Town's evaluation indicates that the following elements will need amendments to comply with the new state requirements:
