2. Update on Dune crossover and shower renovations – Mr. Thomas Hernandez, Director of Engineering and Public Works.

Mr. Thomas Hernandez, Director of Engineering and Public Works, gave a update regarding the dune crossover projects. He reviewed the projects currently in design; completed crossover renovations; the existing and proposed condition of crossover 45,46, 50 and 52. He also mentioned the shower drain at crossover 46 was going to be updated to install a large basin drain and reinstall the concrete pad and shower. LC

Mr. Hernandez and the Committee discussed the crossover drawings, material, and reduction of sea grapes on the beach.

Ms. Whipple asked if Palm Beach County Environmental Resource Management (ERM) knew about the sea grape issue.

3. Friends of Jupiter Beach - Quarterly Update.
