SUBJECT: FY 2019 Mid-Year Budget Amendment

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff seeks Town Council approval of Resolution 44-19 providing for an amendment to the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019 operating and CIP budgets. The amendment includes budget transfers recorded from October 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019 as detailed in the attached budget transfer summary. The most significant amendments by fund are listed below.

General Fund:

Amendments to the General Fund budget were required for the following:

- 1. To carryforward funds from FY 2018 business development grants.
- 2. Appropriate wellness funds received from Bluecross/Blue Shield for Town Wellness Program costs and reduce general fund funding.
- 3. Appropriated funds for payments received for candidate filing fees paid to the state.
- 4. To carryforward FY2018 funds into FY2019 for two dump trucks and a backhoe/loader that was not purchased before year-end.
- 5. Appropriated insurance funds for landscape and property repairs from accidents along Town roadways.
- 6. To carryforward FY2018 operating funds into FY2019 for a police patrol vehicle and balistic vest that were not purchased by year-end.
- 7. To carryforward FY2018 federal forfeiture funds into FY2019 for Peer Support Group expenditures that were not expensed by year-end.
- 8. To carryforward FY2018 federal forfeiture appropriations for authorized improvements to the PD training room that were not completed by year-end.

There has been no use of Town contingency funds in the first half of the fiscal year.

State Forfeiture Fund:

1. To carryforward FY2018 appropriations for authorized security improvements at the Jupiter Community Center that were not completed by year-end.

CRA:

The Town's Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) utilized FY 2018 carryforward funds for previously approved CIP projects. In addition to FY 2018 carryforward funds, on 02/13/2019 the CRA Board authorized the transfer of funds for the Indiantown Rd/US1 project to the CIP fund.

Community Investment Plan (CIP):

Amendments to the CIP fund were required for the following:

- 1. To carryforward funds from FY2018 for previously approved CIP projects.
- 2. To appropriate and transfer funds from the sales surtax fund for the Kaufman Lynn construction contract to the CIP fund for the PD/Data Center Project. Authorized by Town Council on 02/19/2019.

RESOLUTION NO. 44-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 66-18, THE TOWN'S BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Jupiter has adopted its Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget and Pay Plan pursuant to Resolution 66-18 on September 20, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager recognizes that periodic modifications to the adopted budget for the fiscal year are necessary for fiscal management purposes and to implement those changes to the Town Council's fiscal policy which occur after the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2018 - 2019 Budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER, FLORIDA:

- **SECTION 1**. The Town Council hereby amends Resolution 66-18, the Town's Budget for Fiscal Year 2018 2019 to provide for certain adjustments and amendments to the Town Council's fiscal policy which it has made during the course of the fiscal year.
- **SECTION 2.** The Town Council hereby adopts those Budget transfers recorded through March 31, 2019 which are attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- **SECTION 3.** To the extent not amended herein, all other provisions of the Annual Budget for Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2019 remain in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Resolution is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Resolution.
- **SECTION 5.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon execution.
